DAY 1

Hope: Hosea 2:15

¹⁵ I will return her vineyards to her and transform the Valley of Trouble into a gateway of hope. She will give herself to Me there, as she did long ago when she was young, when I freed her from her captivity in Egypt.

Healing: Malachi 4:2

² “But for you who fear My name, the Sun of Righteousness will rise with healing in His wings. And you will go free, leaping with joy like calves let out to pasture.

Restoration: Ezekiel 36:25-28

²⁵ “Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean. Your filth will be washed away, and you will no longer worship idols. ²⁶ And I will give you a new heart, and I will put a new spirit in you. I will take out your stony, stubborn heart and give you a tender, responsive heart. ²⁷ And I will put My Spirit in you so that you will follow My decrees and be careful to obey My regulations. ²⁸ “And you will live in Israel, the land I gave your ancestors long ago. You will be My people, and I will be your God.



DAY 2

Hope: Psalm 126:1-3

¹ When the LORD brought back His exiles to Jerusalem, it was like a dream! ² We were filled with laughter, and we sang for joy. And the other nations said, “What amazing things the LORD has done for them.” ³ Yes, the LORD has done amazing things for us! What joy!

Healing: Luke 10:8-9

⁸ “If you enter a town and it welcomes you, eat whatever is set before you. ⁹ Heal the sick, and tell them, ‘The Kingdom of God is near you now.’”

Restoration: Job 22:27-30

²⁷ You will pray to Him, and He will hear you, and you will fulfil your vows to Him. ²⁸ You will succeed in whatever you choose to do, and light will shine on the road ahead of you. ²⁹ If people are in trouble and you say, ‘Help them,’ God will save them. ³⁰ Even sinners will be rescued; they will be rescued because your hands are pure.”

DAY 3

Hope: Lamentations 3:26

²⁶ So it is good to wait quietly for salvation from the LORD.

Healing: Jeremiah 32:27

²⁷ “I am the LORD, the God of all the peoples of the world. Is anything too hard for me?”

Restoration: Ruth 4:15

¹⁵ May He restore your youth and care for you in your old age. For he is the son of your daughter-in-law who loves you and has been better to you than seven sons!”

DAY 4

Hope: Romans 12:12

¹² Rejoice in our confident hope. Be patient in trouble, and keep on praying.

Healing: Jeremiah 17:14

¹⁴ O LORD, if you heal me, I will be truly healed; if you save me, I will be truly saved. My praises are for you alone!



Restoration: John 14:13–14

¹³ You can ask for anything in My name, and I will do it, so that the Son can bring glory to the Father. ¹⁴ Yes, ask Me for anything in My name, and I will do it!

DAY 5

Hope: Romans 15:13

¹³ I pray that God, the source of hope, will fill you completely with joy and peace because you trust in Him. Then you will overflow with confident hope through the power of the Holy Spirit.

Healing James 5:16

¹⁶ Confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The earnest prayer of a righteous person has great power and produces wonderful results.

Restoration Jeremiah 33:9

⁹ Then this city will bring Me joy, glory, and honour before all the nations of the earth! The people of the world will see all the good I do for My people, and they will tremble with awe at the peace and prosperity I provide for them.

DAY 6

Hope: Jeremiah 29:11

¹¹ For I know the plans I have for you,” says the LORD. “They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope.

Healing: 1 Peter 2:24

²⁴ He personally carried our sins in His body on the cross so that we can be dead to sin and live for what is right. By His wounds you are healed.

Restoration: Isaiah 41:10

¹⁰ Don't be afraid, for I am with you. Don't be discouraged, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you. I will hold you up with My victorious right hand.

DAY 7

Hope: 1 Thessalonians 2:19

¹⁹ After all, what gives us hope and joy, and what will be our proud reward and crown as we stand before our Lord Jesus when He returns? It is you!



Healing: Isaiah 53:5

⁵ But He was pierced for our rebellion, crushed for our sins. He was beaten so we could be whole. He was whipped so we could be healed.

Restoration: Jeremiah 31:18-19

¹⁸ I have heard Israel saying, ‘You disciplined me severely, like a calf that needs training or the yoke. Turn me again to you and restore me, for you alone are the LORD my God. ¹⁹ I turned away from God, but then I was sorry. I kicked myself for my stupidity! I was thoroughly ashamed of all I did in my younger days.’

DAY 8

Hope: Deuteronomy 31:6

⁶ So be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid and do not panic before them. For the LORD your God will personally go ahead of you. He will neither fail you nor abandon you.”

Healing: Matthew 8:1-4

¹ Large crowds followed Jesus as He came down the mountainside. ² Suddenly, a man with leprosy approached Him and knelt before Him. “Lord,” the man said, “if you are willing, you can heal me and make me clean.” ³ Jesus reached out and touched him. “I am willing,” He said. “Be healed!” And instantly the leprosy disappeared. ⁴ Then Jesus said to him, “Don’t tell anyone about this. Instead, go to the priest and let him examine you. Take along the offering required in the law of Moses for those who have been healed of leprosy. This will be a public testimony that you have been cleansed.”

Restoration: Deuteronomy 30:3-5

³ then the LORD your God will restore your fortunes. He will have mercy on you and gather you back from all the nations where He has scattered you. ⁴ Even though you are banished to the ends of the earth, the LORD your God will gather you from there and bring you back again. ⁵ The LORD your God will return you to the land that belonged to your ancestors, and you will possess that land again. Then He will make you even more prosperous and numerous than your ancestors!

DAY 9

Hope: Isaiah 40:31

³¹ But those who trust in the LORD will find new strength. They will soar high on wings like eagles. They will run and not grow weary. They will walk and not faint.



Healing: Psalm 103:2-4

² Let all that I am praise the LORD; may I never forget the good things He does for me. ³ He forgives all my sins and heals all my diseases. ⁴ He redeems me from death and crowns me with love and tender mercies.

Restoration: John 10:10

¹⁰ The thief's purpose is to steal and kill and destroy. My purpose is to give them a rich and satisfying life.

DAY 10

Hope: 1 Corinthians 13:6-7

⁶ It does not rejoice about injustice but rejoices whenever the truth wins out. ⁷ Love never gives up, never loses faith, is always hopeful, and endures through every circumstance.

Healing: James 5:14

¹⁴ Are any of you sick? You should call for the elders of the church to come and pray over you, anointing you with oil in the name of the Lord.

Restoration: Jeremiah 32:14-15

¹⁴ "This is what the LORD of Heaven's Armies, the God of Israel, says: 'Take both this sealed deed and the unsealed copy, and put them into a pottery jar to preserve them for a long time.' ¹⁵ For this is what the LORD of Heaven's Armies, the God of Israel, says: 'Someday people will again own property here in this land and will buy and sell houses and vineyards and fields.'"

DAY 11

Hope: Psalm 39:7

⁷ And so, Lord, where do I put my hope? My only hope is in you.

Healing: Matthew 9:4-8

⁴ Jesus knew what they were thinking, so He asked them, "Why do you have such evil thoughts in your hearts? ⁵ Is it easier to say 'Your sins are forgiven,' or 'Stand up and walk'?" ⁶ So I will prove to you that the Son of Man has the authority on earth to forgive sins." Then Jesus turned to the paralyzed man and said, "Stand up, pick up your mat, and go home!" ⁷ And the man jumped up and went home! ⁸ Fear swept through the crowd as they saw this happen. And they praised God for giving humans such authority.

Restoration: Psalm 71:20-21

²⁰ You have allowed me to suffer much hardship, but you will restore me to life again and lift me up from the depths of the earth. ²¹ You will restore me to even greater honour and comfort me once again.

DAY 12

Hope: Mark 9:22-24

²² The spirit often throws him into the fire or into water, trying to kill him. Have mercy on us and help us, if you can.” ²³ “What do you mean, ‘If I can?’” Jesus asked. “Anything is possible if a person believes.” ²⁴ The father instantly cried out, “I do believe, but help me overcome my unbelief!”

Healing: 3 John 1:2

² Dear friend, I hope all is well with you and that you are as healthy in body as you are strong in spirit.

Restoration: Jeremiah 30:1-3

¹ The LORD gave another message to Jeremiah. He said, ² “This is what the LORD, the God of Israel, says: Write down for the record everything I have said to you, Jeremiah. ³ For the time is coming when I will restore the fortunes of My people of Israel and Judah. I will bring them home to this land that I gave to their ancestors, and they will possess it again. I, the LORD, have spoken!”

DAY 13

Hope: Proverbs 10:24

²⁴ The fears of the wicked will be fulfilled; the hopes of the Godly will be granted.

Healing: Psalm 73:26

²⁶ My health may fail, and my spirit may grow weak, but God remains the strength of my heart; He is mine forever.

Restoration: Philippians 4:19

¹⁹ And this same God who takes care of me will supply all your needs from His glorious riches, which have been given to us in Christ Jesus.

DAY 14

Hope: Proverbs 23:18

¹⁸ You will be rewarded for this; your hope will not be disappointed.

Healing: Psalm 147:3

³ He heals the broken-hearted and bandages their wounds.

Restoration: Joel 2:25-26

²⁵ The LORD says, “I will give you back what you lost to the swarming locusts, the hopping locusts, the stripping locusts, and the cutting locusts. It was I who sent this great destroying army against you. ²⁶ Once again you will have all the food you want, and you will praise the LORD your God, who does these miracles for you. Never again will My people be disgraced.

DAY 15

Hope: Romans 8:24-25

²⁴ We were given this hope when we were saved. If we already have something, we don't need to hope for it. ²⁵ But if we look forward to something we don't yet have, we must wait patiently and confidently.

Healing: Matthew 10:1

¹ Jesus called His twelve disciples together and gave them authority to cast out evil spirits and to heal every kind of disease and illness.

Restoration: Psalm 51:12

¹² Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and make me willing to obey you.

DAY 16

Hope: Jeremiah 17:7

⁷ “But blessed are those who trust in the LORD and have made the LORD their hope and confidence.

Healing: Proverbs 17:22

²² A cheerful heart is good medicine, but a broken spirit saps a person's strength.

Restoration: Zechariah 1:17

¹⁷ “Say this also: ‘This is what the Lord of Heaven’s Armies says: The towns of Israel will again overflow with prosperity, and the Lord will again comfort Zion and choose Jerusalem as His own.’”

DAY 17

Hope: Proverbs 10:28

²⁸ The hopes of the Godly result in happiness, but the expectations of the wicked come to nothing.

Healing: Matthew 10:8

⁸ Heal the sick, raise the dead, cure those with leprosy, and cast out demons. Give as freely as you have received!

Restoration: Acts 3:19-21

¹⁹ Now repent of your sins and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped away. ²⁰ Then times of refreshment will come from the presence of the Lord, and He will again send you Jesus, your appointed Messiah. ²¹ For He must remain in heaven until the time for the final restoration of all things, as God promised long ago through His holy prophets.

DAY 18

Hope: Psalm 71:14

¹⁴ But I will keep on hoping for your help; I will praise you more and more.

Healing: Deuteronomy 7:15

¹⁵ And the Lord will protect you from all sickness. He will not let you suffer from the terrible diseases you knew in Egypt, but He will inflict them on all your enemies!

Restoration: Job 42:10

¹⁰ When Job prayed for his friends, the Lord restored his fortunes. In fact, the Lord gave him twice as much as before!

DAY 19

Hope: Proverbs 13:12

¹² Hope deferred makes the heart sick, but a dream fulfilled is a tree of life.



Healing: Jeremiah 30:17

¹⁷ I will give you back your health and heal your wounds,” says the LORD. “For you are called an outcast— ‘Jerusalem for whom no one cares.’”

Restoration: 1 John 5:4

⁴ For every child of God defeats this evil world, and we achieve this victory through our faith.

DAY 20

Hope: Hebrews 11:1

¹ Faith shows the reality of what we hope for; it is the evidence of things we cannot see.

Healing: Acts 4:30

³⁰ Stretch out your hand with healing power; may miraculous signs and wonders be done through the name of your holy servant Jesus.”

Restoration: Mark 11:24

²⁴ I tell you, you can pray for anything, and if you believe that you’ve received it, it will be yours.

DAY 21

Hope: 1 Peter 3:15

¹⁵ Instead, you must worship Christ as Lord of your life. And if someone asks about your hope as a believer, always be ready to explain it.

Healing: Jeremiah 33:6

⁶ “Nevertheless, the time will come when I will heal Jerusalem’s wounds and give it prosperity and true peace.

Restoration: Revelations 21:1-5

¹ Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the old heaven and the old earth had disappeared. And the sea was also gone. ² And I saw the holy city, the new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven like a bride beautifully dressed for her husband. ³ I heard a loud shout from the throne, saying, “Look, God’s home is now among His people! He will live with them, and they will be His people. God Himself will be with them. ⁴ He will wipe every tear from their eyes, and there will be no more death or sorrow or crying or pain. All these things are gone forever.” ⁵ And



the one sitting on the throne said, “Look, I am making everything new!” And then He said to me, “Write this down, for what I tell you is trustworthy and true.”

DAY 22

Hope: Hebrews 11:10-11

¹⁰ Abraham was confidently looking forward to a city with eternal foundations, a city designed and built by God. ¹¹ It was by faith that even Sarah was able to have a child, though she was barren and was too old. She believed that God would keep His promise.

Healing: Proverbs 4:20-22

²⁰ My child, pay attention to what I say. Listen carefully to my words. ²¹ Don't lose sight of them. Let them penetrate deep into your heart, ²² for they bring life to those who find them, and healing to their whole body.

Restoration: 1 Peter 5:10

¹⁰ In His kindness God called you to share in His eternal glory by means of Christ Jesus. So, after you have suffered a little while, He will restore, support, and strengthen you, and He will place you on a firm foundation.

DAY 23

Hope: Job 14: 7-9

⁷ “Even a tree has more hope! If it is cut down, it will sprout again and grow new branches. ⁸ Though its roots have grown old in the earth and its stump decays, ⁹ at the scent of water it will bud and sprout again like a new seedling.

Healing: Philippians 4:6-7

⁶ Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank Him for all He has done. ⁷ Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus.

Restoration: Zechariah 9:12

¹² Come back to the place of safety, all you prisoners who still have hope! I promise this very day that I will repay two blessings for each of your troubles.

DAY 24

Hope: Psalm 71:5-6

⁵ O Lord, you alone are my hope. I've trusted you, O LORD, from childhood. ⁶ Yes, you have been with me from birth; from my mother's womb you have cared for me. No wonder I am always praising you!

Healing: Isaiah 58:8

⁸ "Then your salvation will come like the dawn, and your wounds will quickly heal. Your godliness will lead you forward, and the glory of the Lord will protect you from behind.

Restoration: Isaiah 42:1-4

¹ "Look at My servant, whom I strengthen. He is My chosen one, who pleases Me. I have put My Spirit upon him. He will bring justice to the nations. ² He will not shout or raise his voice in public. ³ He will not crush the weakest reed or put out a flickering candle. He will bring justice to all who have been wronged. ⁴ He will not falter or lose heart until justice prevails throughout the earth. Even distant lands beyond the sea will wait for his instruction."

DAY 25

Hope: Psalm 43:5

⁵ Why am I discouraged? Why is my heart so sad? I will put my hope in God! I will praise Him again— my Savior and my God!

Healing: Hosea 6:1

¹ "Come, let us return to the LORD. He has torn us to pieces; now He will heal us. He has injured us; now He will bandage our wounds.

Restoration: 2 Samuel 9:7-9

⁷ "Don't be afraid!" David said. "I intend to show kindness to you because of my promise to your father, Jonathan. I will give you all the property that once belonged to your grandfather Saul, and you will eat here with me at the king's table!"

⁸ Mephibosheth bowed respectfully and exclaimed, "Who is your servant, that you should show such kindness to a dead dog like me?" ⁹ Then the king summoned Saul's servant Ziba and said, "I have given your master's grandson everything that belonged to Saul and his family.

DAY 26

Hope: Isaiah 54:17

¹⁷ But in that coming day no weapon turned against you will succeed. You will silence every voice raised up to accuse you. These benefits are enjoyed by the servants of the LORD; their vindication will come from Me. I, the LORD, have spoken!

Healing: Revelation 22:2

² It flowed down the centre of the main street. On each side of the river grew a tree of life, bearing twelve crops of fruit, with a fresh crop each month. The leaves were used for medicine to heal the nations.

Restoration: John 14:2-3

² There is more than enough room in My Father's home. If this were not so, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you? ³ When everything is ready, I will come and get you, so that you will always be with Me where I am.

DAY 27

Hope: Psalm 119:147

¹⁴⁷ I rise early, before the sun is up; I cry out for help and put my hope in your words.

Healing: Mark 2:17

¹⁷ When Jesus heard this, He told them, "Healthy people don't need a doctor—sick people do. I have come to call not those who think they are righteous, but those who know they are sinners."

Restoration: Galatians 6:1

¹ Dear brothers and sisters, if another believer is overcome by some sin, you who are Godly should gently and humbly help that person back onto the right path. And be careful not to fall into the same temptation yourself.

DAY 28

Hope: Jeremiah 31:13

¹³ The young women will dance for joy, and the men—old and young—will join in the celebration. I will turn their mourning into joy. I will comfort them and exchange their sorrow for rejoicing.

Healing: Proverbs 3:5-8

⁵ Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. ⁶ Seek His will in all you do, and He will show you which path to take. ⁷ Don't be impressed with your own wisdom. Instead, fear the Lord and turn away from evil. ⁸ Then you will have healing for your body and strength for your bones.

Restoration: Matthew 6:33

³³ Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and He will give you everything you need.

DAY 29

Hope: 2 Corinthians 3:12

¹² Since this new way gives us such confidence, we can be very bold.

Healing: Psalm 6:2

² Have compassion on me, LORD, for I am weak. Heal me, LORD, for my bones are in agony.

Restoration: Joel 2:22-24

²² Don't be afraid, you animals of the field, for the wilderness pastures will soon be green. The trees will again be filled with fruit; fig trees and grapevines will be loaded down once more. ²³ Rejoice, you people of Jerusalem! Rejoice in the LORD your God! For the rain He sends demonstrates His faithfulness. Once more the autumn rains will come, as well as the rains of spring. ²⁴ The threshing floors will again be piled high with grain, and the presses will overflow with new wine and olive oil.

DAY 30

Hope: Psalm 31:24

²⁴ So be strong and courageous, all you who put your hope in the Lord!

Healing: Proverbs 16:24

²⁴ Kind words are like honey—sweet to the soul and healthy for the body.

Restoration: 2 Corinthians 5:17

¹⁷ This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!

DAY 31

Hope: Lamentations 3:24

²⁴ I say to myself, “The LORD is my inheritance; therefore, I will hope in Him!”

Healing: Acts 19:11-12

¹¹ God gave Paul the power to perform unusual miracles. ¹² When handkerchiefs or aprons that had merely touched his skin were placed on sick people, they were healed of their diseases, and evil spirits were expelled.

Restoration: Psalm 23:1-3

¹ The Lord is my shepherd; I have all that I need. ² He lets me rest in green meadows; He leads me beside peaceful streams. ³ He renews my strength. He guides me along right paths, bringing honour to His name.

DAY 32

Hope: Psalm 33:18

¹⁸ But the LORD watches over those who fear Him, those who rely on His unfailing love.

Healing: Isaiah 57:18

¹⁸ I have seen what they do, but I will heal them anyway! I will lead them. I will comfort those who mourn,

Restoration: Joshua 1:9

⁹ This is My command—be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid or discouraged. For the LORD your God is with you wherever you go.”

DAY 33

Hope: 1 John 3:3

³ And all who have this eager expectation will keep themselves pure, just as He is pure.

Healing: Numbers 12:13

¹³ So Moses cried out to the LORD, “O God, I beg you, please heal her!”

Restoration: 2 Samuel 14:14

¹⁴ All of us must die eventually. Our lives are like water spilled out on the ground, which cannot be gathered up again. But God does not just sweep life away; instead, He devises ways to bring us back when we have been separated from Him.

DAY 34

Hope: Job 11:18

¹⁸ Having hope will give you courage. You will be protected and will rest in safety.

Healing: Matthew 11:28

²⁸ Then Jesus said, “Come to me, all of you who are weary and carry heavy burdens, and I will give you rest.

Restoration: 2 Chronicles 30:9

⁹ “For if you return to the LORD, your relatives and your children will be treated mercifully by their captors, and they will be able to return to this land. For the LORD your God is gracious and merciful. If you return to Him, He will not continue to turn His face from you.”

DAY 35

Hope: Psalm 10:17

¹⁷ Lord, you know the hopes of the helpless. Surely you will hear their cries and comfort them.

Healing: 2 Corinthians 12:9

⁹ Each time said, “My grace is all you need. My power works best in weakness.”

Restoration: Psalm 51:7-8

⁷ Purify me from my sins, and I will be clean; wash me, and I will be whiter than snow. ⁸ Oh, give me back my joy again; you have broken me — now let me rejoice.

DAY 36

Hope: Psalm 9:18

¹⁸ But the needy will not be ignored forever; the hopes of the poor will not always be crushed.

Healing: Isaiah 38:16-17

¹⁶ Lord, your discipline is good, for it leads to life and health. You restore my health and allow me to live! ¹⁷ Yes, this anguish was good for me, for you have rescued me from death and forgiven all my sins.

Restoration: John 5:24

²⁴ “I tell you the truth, those who listen to My message and believe in God who sent Me have eternal life. They will never be condemned for their sins, but they have already passed from death into life.

DAY 37

Hope: Psalm 78:7

⁷ So each generation should set its hope anew on God, not forgetting His glorious miracles and obeying His commands.

Healing: Psalm 146:8

⁸ The LORD opens the eyes of the blind. The LORD lifts up those who are weighed down. The LORD loves the Godly.

Restoration: Jeremiah 29:12-14

¹² In those days when you pray, I will listen. ¹³ If you look for Me wholeheartedly, you will find Me. ¹⁴ I will be found by you,” says the LORD. “I will end your captivity and restore your fortunes. I will gather you out of the nations where I sent you and will bring you home again to your own land.”

DAY 38

Hope: Psalm 38:15

¹⁵ For I am waiting for you, O Lord. You must answer for me, O Lord my God.

Healing: Luke 4:18

¹⁸ “The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, for He has anointed Me to bring Good News to the poor. He has sent Me to proclaim that captives will be released, that the blind will see, that the oppressed will be set free,

Restoration: 2 Samuel 19:14-18

¹⁴ Then Amasa convinced all the men of Judah, and they responded unanimously. They sent word to the king, “Return to us, and bring back all who are with you.”

¹⁵ So the king started back to Jerusalem. And when he arrived at the Jordan River,

the people of Judah came to Gilgal to meet him and escort him across the river. ¹⁶ Shimei son of Gera, the man from Bahurim in Benjamin, hurried across with the men of Judah to welcome King David. ¹⁷ A thousand other men from the tribe of Benjamin were with him, including Ziba, the chief servant of the house of Saul, and Ziba's fifteen sons and twenty servants. They rushed down to the Jordan to meet the king. ¹⁸ They crossed the shallows of the Jordan to bring the king's household across the river, helping him in every way they could. As the king was about to cross the river, Shimei fell down before him.

DAY 39

Hope: Proverbs 3:3-4

³ Never let loyalty and kindness leave you! Tie them around your neck as a reminder. Write them deep within your heart. ⁴ Then you will find favour with both God and people, and you will earn a good reputation.

Healing: John 11:4

⁴ But when Jesus heard about it, He said, "Lazarus's sickness will not end in death. No, it happened for the glory of God so that the Son of God will receive glory from this."

Restoration: Psalm 51:10-11

¹⁰ Create in me a clean heart, O God. Renew a loyal spirit within me. ¹¹ Do not banish me from your presence, and don't take your Holy Spirit from me.

DAY 40

Hope: Psalm 130:5

⁵ I am counting on the LORD; yes, I am counting on Him. I have put my hope in His word.

Healing: John 9:24-25

DAY 74

¹¹ Our great desire is that you will keep on loving others as long as life lasts, in order to make certain that what you hope for will come true.

Healing: Exodus 23:25

²⁵ “You must serve only the LORD your God. If you do, I will bless you with food and water, and I will protect you from illness.

Restoration: Micah 7:19-20

¹⁹ Once again you will have compassion on us. You will trample our sins under your feet and throw them into the depths of the ocean! ²⁰ You will show us your faithfulness and unfailing love as you promised to our ancestors Abraham and Jacob long ago.

DAY 75

Hope: Jeremiah 17:17

¹⁷ LORD, don't terrorize me! You alone are my hope in the day of disaster.

Healing: Psalm 119:107

¹⁰⁷ I have suffered much, O LORD; restore my life again as you promised.

Restoration: 2 Kings 8:1-4

DAY 78

⁵ which come from your confident hope of what God has reserved for you in heaven. You have had this expectation ever since you first heard the truth of the Good News.

Healing: Ezekiel 34:16

¹⁶ I will search for My lost ones who strayed away, and I will bring them safely home again. I will bandage the injured and strengthen the weak. But I will destroy those who are fat and powerful. I will feed them, yes—feed them justice!

Restoration: Ezekiel 34:28-31

²⁸ They will no longer be prey for other nations, and wild animals will no longer devour them. They will live in safety, and no one will frighten them. ²⁹ “And I will make their land famous for its crops, so My people will never again suffer from famines or the insults of foreign nations. ³⁰ In this way, they will know that I, the LORD their God, am with them. DAY 83

Hope: Psalm 42:11

¹¹ Why am I discouraged? Why is my heart so sad? I will put my hope in God! I will praise Him again— my Savior and my God!

Healing: Acts 5:15-16

¹⁵ As a result of the apostles' work, sick people were brought out into the streets on beds and mats so that Peter's shadow might fall across some of them as he went by. ¹⁶ Crowds came from the villages around Jerusalem, bringing their sick and those possessed by evil spirits, and they were all healed.

Restoration: 2 Corinthians 5:18-19

¹³ I gave you land you had not worked on, and I gave you towns you did not build—the towns where you are now living. I gave you vineyards and olive groves for food, though you did not plant them.

DAY 87

Hope: Psalm 25:5

Restoration: Job 33:26

DAY 88

Restoration: Isaiah 51:1-3

¹ "Listen to me, all who hope for deliverance—all who seek the LORD! Consider the rock from which you were cut, the quarry from which you were mined. ² Yes, think about Abraham, your ancestor, and Sarah, who gave birth to your nation. Abraham

was only one man when I called him. But when I blessed him, he became a great nation.”³ The LORD will comfort Israel again and have pity on her ruins. Her desert will blossom like Eden, her barren wilderness like the garden of the LORD. Joy and gladness will be found there. Songs of thanksgiving will fill the air.

DAY 89

Hope: Philippians 1:20

²⁰ For I fully expect and hope that I will never be ashamed, but that I will continue to be bold for Christ, as I have been in the past. And I trust that my life will bring honour to Christ, whether I live or die.

Healing: Luke 5:17

¹⁷ One day while Jesus was teaching, some Pharisees and teachers of religious law were sitting nearby. (It seemed that these men showed up from every village in all Galilee and Judea, as well as from Jerusalem.) And the Lord’s healing power was strongly with Jesus.

²⁴ For God is Spirit, so those who worship Him must worship in spirit and in truth.” ²⁵ The woman said, “I know the Messiah is coming—the one who is called Christ. When He comes, He will explain everything to us.” ²⁶ Then Jesus told her, “I AM the Messiah!”



DAY 91

⁴ The LORD says, "Then I will heal you of your faithlessness; My love will know no bounds, for My anger will be gone forever. ⁵ I will be to Israel like a refreshing dew from heaven. Israel will blossom like the lily; it will send roots deep into the soil like the cedars in Lebanon. ⁶ Its branches will spread out like beautiful olive trees, as fragrant as the cedars of Lebanon. ⁷ My people will again live under My shade. They will flourish like grain and blossom like grapevines. They will be as fragrant as the wines of Lebanon.

DAY 92

Hope: 2 Corinthians 4:1

¹ Therefore, since God in His mercy has given us this new way, we never give up.

Healing: John 4:47

⁴⁷ When he heard that Jesus had come from Judea to Galilee, he went and begged Jesus to come to Capernaum to heal his son, who was about to die.

Restoration: Isaiah 1:25-26

²⁵ I will raise My fist against you. I will melt you down and skim off your slag. I will remove all your impurities. ²⁶ Then I will give you good judges again and wise counsellors like you used to have. Then Jerusalem will again be called the Home of Justice and the Faithful City."

DAY 93

Hope: Habbakuk 3:17-19

¹⁷ Even though the fig trees have no blossoms, and there are no grapes on the vines; even though the olive crop fails, and the fields lie empty and barren; even though



the flocks die in the fields, and the cattle barns are empty, ¹⁸ yet I will rejoice in the LORD! I will be joyful in the God of my salvation! ¹⁹ The Sovereign LORD is my strength! He makes me as surefooted as a deer, able to tread upon the heights.

Healing: Psalm 119:92–93

⁹² If your instructions hadn't sustained me with joy, I would have died in my misery.

⁹³ I will never forget your commandments, for by them you give me life.

Restoration: Job 8:6

⁶ and if you are pure and live with integrity, He will surely rise up and restore your happy home.

DAY 94

Hope: 1 Timothy 1:1

¹ This letter is from Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus, appointed by the command of God our Savior and Christ Jesus, who gives us hope.

Healing: Acts 9:40–41

⁴⁰ But Peter asked them all to leave the room; then he knelt and prayed. Turning to the body he said, "Get up, Tabitha." And she opened her eyes! When she saw Peter, she sat up! ⁴¹ He gave her his hand and helped her up. Then he called in the widows and all the believers, and he presented her to them alive.

Restoration: Hebrews 1:1–5

¹ Long ago God spoke many times and in many ways to our ancestors through the prophets. ² And now in these final days, He has spoken to us through His Son. God promised everything to the Son as an inheritance, and through the Son He created the universe. ³ The Son radiates God's own glory and expresses the very character of God, and He sustains everything by the mighty power of His command. When He had cleansed us from our sins, He sat down in the place of honour at the right hand of the majestic God in heaven. ⁴ This shows that the Son is far greater than the angels, just as the name God gave Him is greater than their names. ⁵ For God never said to any angel what He said to Jesus: "You are My Son. Today I have become your Father." God also said, "*I will be His Father, and He will be My Son.*"

DAY 95

Hope: Acts 23:6

Healing: Psalm 34:20

²⁰ For the LORD protects the bones of the righteous; not one of them is broken!

Restoration: Isaiah 11:6-9

⁶ In that day the wolf and the lamb will live together; the leopard will lie down with the baby goat. The calf and the yearling will be safe with the lion, and a little child will lead them all. ⁷ The cow will graze near the bear. The cub and the calf will lie down together. The lion will eat hay like a cow. ⁸ The baby will play safely near the hole of a cobra. Yes, a little child will put its hand in a nest of deadly snakes without harm. ⁹ Nothing will hurt or destroy in all my holy mountain, for as the waters fill the sea, so the earth will be filled with people who know the LORD.

DAY 96

Hope: Proverbs 14:32

³² The wicked are crushed by disaster, but the godly have a refuge when they die.

Healing: Matthew 15:29-31

²⁹ Jesus returned to the Sea of Galilee and climbed a hill and sat down. ³⁰ A vast crowd brought to Him people who were lame, blind, crippled, those who couldn't speak, and many others. They laid them before Jesus, and He healed them all. ³¹ The crowd was amazed! Those who hadn't been able to speak were talking, the crippled were made well, the lame were walking, and the blind could see again! And they praised the God of Israel.

Restoration: Psalm 45:10-15

¹⁰ Listen to me, O royal daughter; take to heart what I say. Forget your people and your family far away. ¹¹ For your royal husband delights in your beauty; honour him, for He is your lord. ¹² The princess of Tyre will shower you with gifts. The wealthy will beg your favour. ¹³ The bride, a princess, looks glorious in her golden gown. ¹⁴ In her beautiful robes, she is led to the king, accompanied by her bridesmaids. ¹⁵ What a joyful and enthusiastic procession as they enter the king's palace!

DAY 97

Hope: 1 Thessalonians 4:13

¹³ And now, dear brothers and sisters, we want you to know what will happen to the believers who have died so you will not grieve like people who have no hope.

Healing: Matthew 28:6-7

⁶ He isn't here! He is risen from the dead, just as He said would happen. Come, see where His body was lying. ⁷ And now, go quickly and tell His disciples that He has risen from the dead, and He is going ahead of you to Galilee. You will see Him there. Remember what I have told you."

Restoration: Ezra 3:1-5

¹ In early autumn, when the Israelites had settled in their towns, all the people assembled in Jerusalem with a unified purpose. ² Then Jeshua son of Jehozadak joined his fellow priests and Zerubbabel son of Shealtiel with his family in rebuilding the altar of the God of Israel. They wanted to sacrifice burnt offerings on it, as instructed in the Law of Moses, the man of God. ³ Even though the people were afraid of the local residents, they rebuilt the altar at its old site. Then they began to sacrifice burnt offerings on the altar to the LORD each morning and evening. ⁴ They celebrated the Festival of Shelters as prescribed in the Law, sacrificing the number of burnt offerings specified for each day of the festival. ⁵ They also offered the regular burnt offerings and the offerings required for the new moon celebrations and the annual festivals as prescribed by the LORD. The people also gave voluntary offerings to the LORD.

DAY 98

¹⁸ I cried out, "I am slipping!" but your unfailing love, O Lord, supported me.

¹⁹ When doubts filled my mind, your comfort gave me renewed hope and cheer.

Healing: Acts 9:17-18

¹⁷ So Ananias went and found Saul. He laid his hands on him and said, "Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus, who appeared to you on the road, has sent me so that you might regain your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit." ¹⁸ Instantly something like scales fell from Saul's eyes, and he regained his sight. Then he got up and was baptized.

Restoration: Amos 9:11-12

¹¹ "In that day I will restore the fallen house of David. I will repair its damaged walls. From the ruins I will rebuild it and restore its former glory. ¹² And Israel will



possess what is left of Edom and all the nations I have called to be mine.”
The LORD has spoken, and He will do these things.

DAY 99

Hope: Colossians 1:27

²⁷ For God wanted them to know that the riches and glory of Christ are for you Gentiles, too. And this is the secret: Christ lives in you. This gives you assurance of sharing His glory.

Healing: Psalm 6:3-4

³ I am sick at heart. How long, O Lord, until you restore me? ⁴ Return, O Lord, and rescue me. Save me because of your unfailing love.

Restoration: Psalm 86:4-7

⁴ Give me happiness, O Lord, for I give myself to you. ⁵ O Lord, you are so good, so ready to forgive, so full of unfailing love for all who ask for your help. ⁶ Listen closely to my prayer, O Lord; hear my urgent cry. ⁷ I will call to you whenever I'm in trouble, and you will answer.

DAY 100

Hope: Isaiah 55:10-11

¹⁰ “The rain and snow come down from the heavens and stay on the ground to water the earth. They cause the grain to grow, producing seed for the farmer and bread for the hungry. ¹¹ It is the same with My word. I send it out, and it always produces fruit. It will accomplish all I want it to, and it will prosper everywhere I send it.

Healing: Matthew 14:34-35

³⁴ After they had crossed the lake, they landed at Gennesaret. ³⁵ When the people recognized Jesus, the news of His arrival spread quickly throughout the whole area, and soon people were bringing all their sick to be healed.

Restoration: Joshua 21:43-45

⁴³ So the Lord gave to Israel all the land He had sworn to give their ancestors, and they took possession of it and settled there. ⁴⁴ And the Lord gave them rest on every side, just as He had solemnly promised their ancestors. None of their enemies could stand against them, for the Lord helped them conquer all their enemies. ⁴⁵ Not a single one of all the good promises the Lord had given to the family of Israel was left unfulfilled; everything He had spoken came true.
